CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER/LICENSED PLUMBING INSPECTOR

The Town of Thomaston is seeking qualified candidates for a Code Enforcement Officer/Licensed Plumbing Inspector position. The position is approximately 30 hours per week. This is a technical and administrative position responsible for overseeing the Town's land use and development activities to ensure compliance with construction and zoning codes, ordinances, and other regulatory requirements. Reviews residential and commercial construction plans, issues permits, and inspects construction work, including buildings, septic systems, and plumbing. Interprets and enforces zoning and land use ordinances, educates the public, investigates, and resolves complaints, and maintains accurate records.

The position provides staff support to the Board of Appeals and the Planning Board. Additionally, the position administers workplace safety programs for all town departments and develops employee safety training in compliance with Maine Department of Labor.

Graduation from high school or equivalent is required. Qualified applicants must possess a valid Maine Driver's License and a properly registered and insured private vehicle for job use. Must successfully complete a background check. This position requires an individual certified by the State of Maine or the ability to obtain all certifications within 12 months of their appointment. Preference will be given to applicants with municipal or building industry experience.

The position offers benefits that include paid holidays, earned paid leave, (dental, short-term disability, and vision paid by the employee only), health insurance stipend, mileage stipend, and cell phone.
